



COVID-19 Long-Term Care and Medical Rehabilitation Visitation Guidelines

HealthSource Saginaw is utilizing guidance from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for visitation.

Procedure for indoor visitation:

- Visitors must be willing and able to adhere to HealthSource Saginaw's COVID-19 visitation guidelines, or visitation will be denied.
 - Visitors must use hand sanitizer at the beginning of the visit and upon entering and exiting patient/resident rooms.
 - Residents and visitors age 3 and older will be required to wear facemasks throughout the visit. Facemasks must be worn covering your nose and mouth.
 - Maintain social distance of 6 feet or more from other residents and families.
- **Please check with the resident or staff to coordinate your visit around therapy and/or appointment schedules, to avoid conflict during your visit.**
- Upon arrival at HealthSource please proceed directly to an entrance kiosk to complete a COVID-19 symptom screening.
- Once entrance screening is complete, a visitation sticker is provided and must be worn while at HealthSource.
 - Visitors should go directly to the patient/resident room. If you are unsure where to go a staff member can escort you.
 - Visitors may take residents to the exterior of the building, courtyards, or other indoor common areas while core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention are adhered to.
 - Visitors and residents **may not** go to other neighborhoods or wander the facility.
- At the end of your visit, return to the reception desk to check out on the kiosk
- Dispose of visitation sticker
- Residents may leave the facility for a family or community outing.
 - Residents must be signed out for a leave of absence at the nurse's station and get instructions for care from the nurse.
- Visitors must notify the facility if they develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 within 14 days after visiting.
