

COVID-19 Behavioral Medicine Center Visitation Guidelines

- Visiting will only occur in the Atriums of each unit in order to maintain social distancing.
- The number of visitors will be limited to no more than 1-2 per patient at a time and a total 10 patients/visitors in a room at a time. In order to accommodate this, visitors will be asked to call ahead and schedule their visit.
- All visitors should utilize the waiting room entrances and call the unit upon arrival. Staff will meet them and conduct a temperature check and screening for signs and symptoms before being allowed into the Atriums to visit. If symptomatic, visitation will not be allowed.
- Masks must be worn by visitors while on the premises and 6' social distancing is to be practiced. Exceptions may be allowed for those medically unable to wear a mask.
- All tables, etc. are to be sanitized after visiting has occurred.
- For those who do not wish to visit in person, tablets for video visits will be provided.

- **Adolescent Unit**
Male: 5:00–6:00 p.m. Sunday
Female: 5:00–6:00 p.m. Saturday
- **Adult Unit**
Male: 7:30–8:30 p.m. Wednesday, Sunday
Female: 7:30–8:30 p.m. Tuesday, Saturday
- **Geriatric Unit**
6:00 – 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday

All Behavioral Medicine Center units have visitation on holidays from 2:00 – 3:00 p.m. and 7:30 – 8:30 p.m.
